They can do a test to see if you have an infection by:

If you need to have a test, the appointment will be 30 minutes long.		
You will nee 10 minutes e	d to go to your early.	appointment



	If you are a man, you must not wee for 2 to 3 hours before your appointment.	
	After the test, you may need to wait for 10 days to find out the results of the test.	
	You can choose to find out the results in a text or a phone call.	
Swish	If you have an infection, you will need to go back to the clinic for treatment.
